DEVELOPMENT AND REFLECTIONS ON A COASTAL MANAGEMENT PROJECT INVOLVING FISHING AND TOURISM ACTIVITIES USING DIGITAL TOOLS

The exploratory project SEARM-FIT, funded by the FCT (Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology), aimed to address the use of artificial reefs along the Algarve coast, exploring the interactions between economic activities such as fishing and tourism. The webinar will provide a comprehensive overview of the work developed over the two-year duration of the project. It will include a review of the methodological work carried out by the multidisciplinary and international team, composed of academics/researchers and master level students. During the presentation, the main results achieved will be discussed in brief, along with the reciprocity of stakeholders and peers, as well as the presentations and publications generated throughout the project.
