# Exchanging Experiences with an International PhD Researcher

Transdisciplinary research is inherently complex as it combines knowledge and approaches from multiple academic disciplines as well as engaging with non-academic stakeholders to explore, analyse, and address societal issues. During this PhD Network Seminar Charlotte will talk about her experiences of undertaking a transdisciplinary PhD at the Horizon Centre for Doctoral Training in the United Kingdom. Her research draws on approaches from the academic fields of human factors (engineering), leisure/tourism studies, and marketing with a focus on improving the accessibility of public transport used for leisure purposes by passengers who are late adopters of technology. The thesis was also developed in close collaboration with an industry partner, Rail Safety and Standards Board, who provided valuable industry insight into the project.
